Pursuant to the dormancy Rules, CDS accounts (individual or Corporate, Local or Foreign) with no activity for a continuous period of twenty four (24) months as at December 31st 2018 were declared dormant on January 1st 2019 by the CDSC.CDS account holders are therefore advised that one may re-activate a dormant account by submitting a duly completed reactivation request and identification documents to their CDA or stockbroker.

#### \*\*\*Announcement

The Unclaimed Financial Assets Authority (UFAA) notified the public that various institutions had reported over 800 million units of unclaimed shares among other assets to the Authority. UFAA advised apparent owners or beneficiaries to lodge claims on these shares by 31 August 2020. Rightful owners are required to obtain a holder's letter from share registrars and submit a claim online via the UFAA website using relevant forms.
